Plotting Pumpkins Decorating Contest

Turn a pumpkin into a hero or villain from a story you've loved! We'll display your creation at the library and the public will vote on their favorites in four categories: Preschool, Ages 5–10, Ages 11–17, and Adult.

Voting ends Tuesday, October 31. Winners will be announced Wednesday, November 1. Pumpkins not retrieved by Saturday, November 4 will be discarded.

Rules:

- Bring your pumpkin to a participating library branch on **Saturday, October 21** between 10:00 and 5:30 and fill out an entry form. (Later submissions are allowed but will have less voting time).
- One pumpkin entry per person or per group.
- Pumpkins should be inspired by a story (book, movie, show, video game, etc.).
- Pumpkins may be painted, stickered, dressed, etc., but please do not puncture them.
- Decorations must be appropriate for all ages.
- If a pumpkin begins to deteriorate before the end of the contest or display period, library staff may discard it at their discretion.
