Optional: Join the challenge in Beanstack to track on your device.



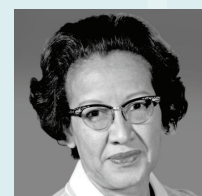
3. SPLASHDOWN!

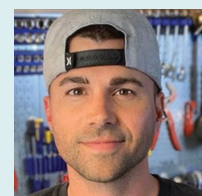
KATHERINE JOHNSON

American astronomer and NASA scientist best known for his research on extraterrestrial life.

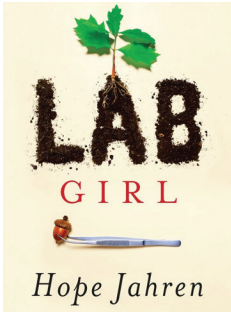


LONNIE JOHNSON
