

Key to instrument families:

● Strings ● Woodwinds ● Brass/Horns ● Percussion

Western musical instruments are divided into four families. String instruments may be plucked or bowed and produce sound through the vibration of their strings. Wind instruments create sound when the player blows air into them through a mouthpiece. Brass instruments make sound through vibrations of the player's lips into the mouthpiece. Percussion instruments make sounds when they are hit, scraped or shaken. World instruments may fit more than one (or none!) of these categories!

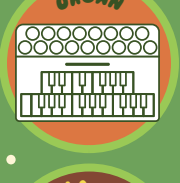
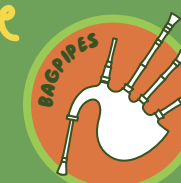
