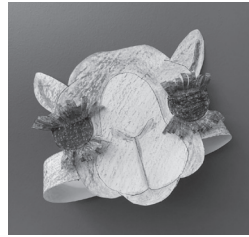
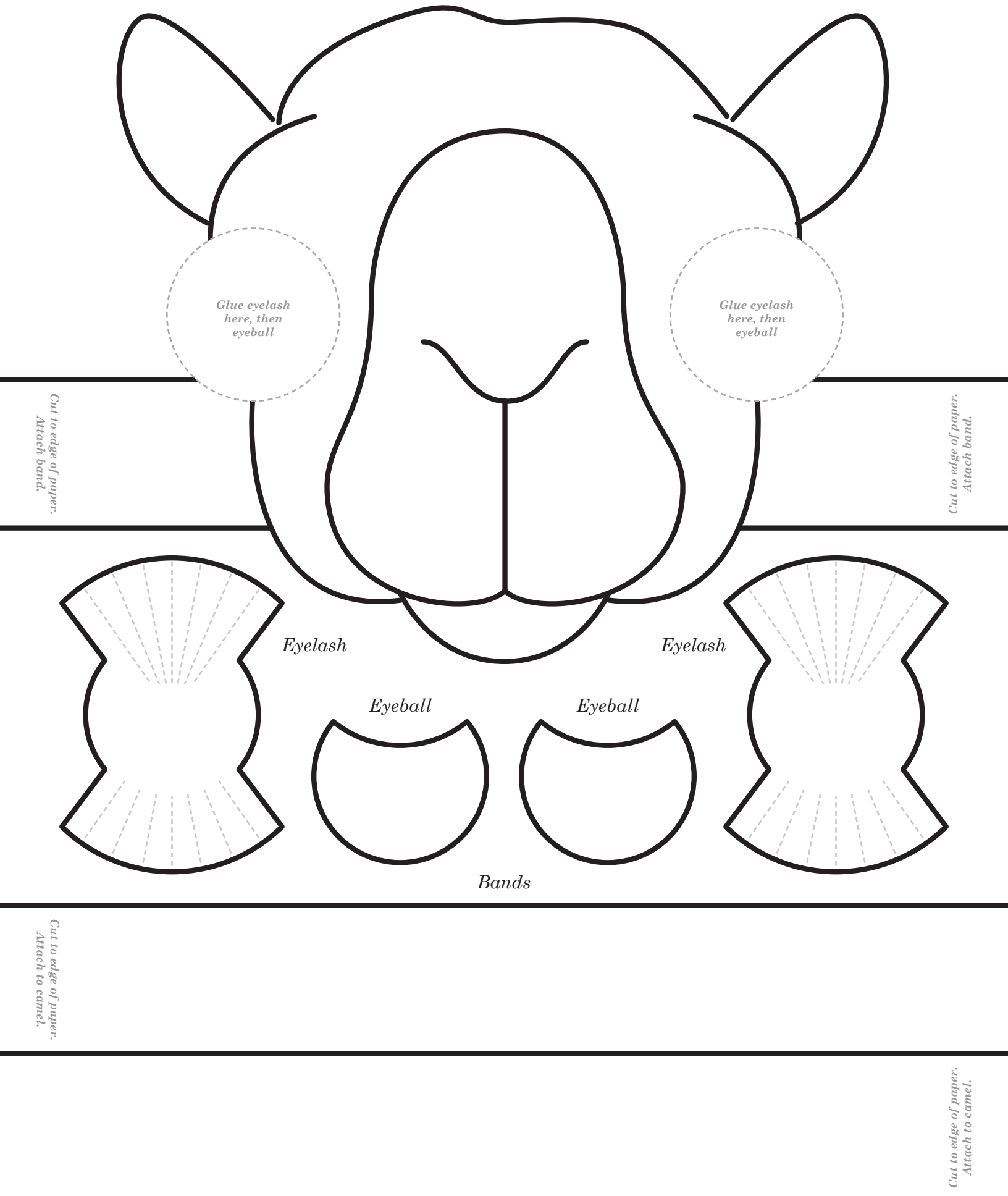


Camel Crown Craft

Color and cut out your camel face, eyelashes, eyeballs, and bands. Cut fringe on your eyelashes, curl if desired, and glue on top of the mask. (Line up with dashed circles.) Then glue eyeballs on top of the eyelashes. Attach one band to each side of the mask, fit to your head, and secure the ends to form a circle.

Camels have three sets of eyelids and two rows of eyelashes to keep sand out of their eyes! Camels can also completely shut their nostrils during sandstorms. Thick pads of skin on their chest and knees allow camels to comfortably sit in the very hot sand of the desert.
